Luke: Waiting on God

Luke 2:21-38

- 1 Out of the depths I cry to you, Lord;
- 2 Lord, hear my voice. Let your ears be attentive to my cry for mercy.
- 3 If you, Lord, kept a record of sins, Lord, who could stand?
- 4 But with you there is forgiveness, therefore you are feared.
- 5 I wait for the Lord, my soul waits, and in his word I put my hope.
- 6 I wait for the Lord more than watchmen wait for the morning, more than watchmen wait for the morning.
- 7 O Israel, put your hope in the Lord, for with the Lord is unfailing love and with him is full redemption.
- 8 He himself will redeem Israel from all their sins.
