- 1. Explain Araunah's attitude toward's the king? Why was this attitude expected in that culture?
- 2. Explain why king David's response is surprising (*verse 24*)? What is commendable about David's intentions?
- 3. How has our culture today removed this attitude of "sacrifice" from our worship? (Example Subject for evaluation: church time, incentives for giving, commitments in serving, fear, participation, etc).
- 4. How was king David "countercultural?" How does Jesus expect the church to act "countercultural" in <u>Matthew 5:3-10</u>? How was the Apostle Paul "countercultural" in <u>Philippians 2:17-18</u>?"
- 5. Share an area from your discipleship journey where God is working on your "countercultural" attitude-of-sacrifice?
