

Video Sermon Notes: April 5th 2020

Easter Reflections: Election

Philippians 1:27-30 + Hebrews 13:5-6

"Because the sinless Savior died My sinful soul is counted free For God, the Just, is satisfied To look on Him and pardon me"

1. The <u>Promise of God's Election</u> is repeated and reminded throughout the Scriptures. When it comes to the subject of *fear* why is it so important to be reminded that we are chosen by God as His children? **READ: Romans 8:15-17**

Verse 17 seems to indicate that Christians will share in Jesus' sufferings. What hope does Easter bring those who are chosen by God and are undergoing a time of suffering?

2. God's <u>Purpose in Election</u> isn't just to use you, but to change you while He is using you. In what ways has God been changing you? **READ: Colossians 3:12-17**

Verse 12 gives three characteristics before the primary verb "clothe". Can you explain the significance of being: (1) "chosen" (2) "holy" and (3) "dearly loved"? What do these three attributes enable you to do?

3. The <u>Privilege of Election</u> is being chosen by God to carry Jesus and put Him on display. In what ways do people see Jesus when they look at you? **READ: 1 Peter 2:9**

If someone were to ask you about Jesus, what reason would you give them for your hope of resurrection? In your everyday life how are you "declaring the praises of Him who called you"?

Please take a minute to reflect on Palm Sunday and the lovingkindness of a God who chose you and transforms you into an instrument of sharing, speaking, and spreading His glory.
