



Video Sermon Notes: April 12th 2020

Easter Reflections: Glorification

Philippians 3:12-14 + Hebrews 1:3

*Come behold the wondrous mystery, slain by death the God of life
But no grave could e'er restrain him, praise the Lord, He is alive
What a foretaste of deliverance, how unwavering our hope
Christ in power resurrected, as will we be when he comes*

1. How risky is it that God would allow His glory to be ascribed by us?

READ: John 15:4-8

According to this passage, what will we produce if we DO NOT remain in Jesus? Who gets the glory if we could actually produce fruit without being Jesus' disciples?

2. The resurrection of Jesus displays the glory of God as the giver of life.

READ: Romans 6:4

Baptism depicts death and new life; how has God given you new life? How does your identification with Jesus display glory to God?

3. Our resurrection is assured by the historical fact of Jesus' resurrection.

For proof, in defense of our future resurrection, Paul writes declaring, "Christ has indeed been raised from the dead" - **1 Co 15:20**.

READ: Ephesians 1:11-14

What role does the Holy Spirit play in confirming God's promise of resurrection, referred to here as "our inheritance" (vs 1:14,18)?

How does the hope of this promise lead you to express the "praise of his glory" (vs 1:12,14)?

Say a prayer with me today along with the angels and the living creatures:

"Worthy is the Lamb, who was slain, to receive power and wealth and wisdom and strength and honor and glory and praise! To Him who sits on the throne and to the Lamb be praise and honor and glory and power forever and ever! Amen!"
