Definitions:both are true for true Christians You have been made positionally holy in Christ by the Spirit ONLY THOSE WHO HAVE BEEN SANCTIFIED CAN BE CALLED "SAINTS"
- You are being renewed behaviorally in Christ by the Spirit ONLY THOSE WHO REQUIRE THE GROWTH PROCESS OF SANCTIFICATION ARE CALLED "SINNERS"
