



## LifeGroup Discussion Guide

### Unseen Sins - Pride

*Remember this page is designed to begin a discussion with your LifeGroup. It is not comprehensive. Allow the following questions to spur on deeper and fuller conversation, study, and discussion.*

Go around and share a moment from your life where "pride" has got you into trouble. How have your experiences proven true the main scripture for today that teaches: *"Pride goes before destruction, a haughty spirit before a fall."* - **Pv 16:18**

Paul taught us that pride is both an action and an attitude. Which of these two do you feel is more dangerous and why? What is it like to have to deal with someone who has a prideful attitude?

**READ: Proverbs 29:23** - If pride has blinded those who have been captured by it, how does humility help reopen our eyes? **READ again: Luke 18:9-14** - What is the critical lesson that Jesus is teaching about humility?

**READ: James 4:6-7** - In our sermon application, Paul challenged us to *"Ask God to dwell with you."* How is this similar to what James is teaching in **verse 7** by challenging his readers to *"submit to God?"*

Next we were told to ask for God's grace. **READ verse 6** again.

**READ: Romans 5:20-21** - How is seeing our need for grace a prerequisite to humility? Do you think delivering this grace is easy or hard for God? Would it be easy or hard for you? What do you think makes it easier for us to give grace to one another, and compare and contrast how that is different from God's grace?

**READ: 1 Corinthians 11:1** - How is the challenge to imitate Jesus' humility also a challenge for us to live this truth out as a model for others?

Go around and share openly what you most struggle with when it comes to pride? Where in your life are you most easily prone to being self-defensive, where you most easily take offense?
